Pre-Entry Requested for paperwork to simplify check-in on show date:
 Weigh in will be 1:00 p.m. - 3:00 p.m. Showmanship Classes will begin at 4:00 p.m.
 Market Classes will begin immediately following Showmanship Classes.

RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR SHOW

- Animals are not to be unloaded until Health Certificates are checked.
 - Any breed or cross breed or goat can be shown. All classes will be shown by weight.
 - 30 pounds minimum weight. There will be 5 divisions of goats shown: market kids and replacement doe kids and yearling does and junior bucks and senior bucks. Buckling's under 1 year by weight and 1 year and over by age. (Market kids will be does and wethers will be put in the ring together by weight. Does in this class will not be eligible for the replacement class.
 - Wether kids must NOT exhibit any testicular tissue. Animals having this will be dismissed.
 - Wether kids and doe kids must have all milk teeth at weigh in. Wethers not having them will be dismissed and does without both milk teeth will be moved to yearling doe division.
 - Yearling does are allowed to have no more than two sets of adult teeth (4 large teeth).
 - All goats must be polled or have their horns either tipped or cushioned with a material to help prevent injury to the exhibitor.
 - All goats must have legible tattoo or scrapie tags in ear in order to show.
 - Each exhibitor is limited to (5) animals for the show. You can show up to 5 bucks also. Pens will be supplied for BUCKS ONLY.
 - All goats will be weighted and classified prior to the show and will be divided into classes in their division.
 - Show management reserves the right to disqualify any animal that exhibits any sign of disease regardless.
 - Robertson County Fair Association is not responsible for any accidents.
- Special Note:*** Federal law requires that all goats that are exhibited in shows must meet USDA Regulations and have a scrapie ID ear tag permanently attached in its ear or other approved ID. Exhibitors may contact the USDA office at (615) 781-5310 to order their tags. Animals without proper scrapie tags and certificate of veterinary inspection will not be allowed to exhibit.
